JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 45 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. (iii) At 16:50, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Jaba’ checkpoint located along the main road connecting Jerusalem, Ramallah and Jericho and as a result impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:15, Israeli forces positioned at Qalandiya checkpoint fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 18:00, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Abu Dis fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iii) At 22:00, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Abu Dis, Al-Eizariya, Jabal Mukabbir, Silwan and Bab Al-Amoud area in Jerusalem

	<p>fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Killing:</u> At 13:50, Israeli forces opened fire towards Mohammad Nayef Ja'abis (A resident of Jabal Mukabbir neighbourhood) and as a result killed him as he ran over an Israeli settler as he was driving a bus in Sheikh Jarrah neighbourhood in Jerusalem during which Israeli forces stormed and searched the above-mentioned resident's home in Jabal Mukabir neighbourhood. • <u>Detention:</u> On August 4TH 2014, Israeli forces detained 10 residents including two children: Foad Ali Al-Khatib (16 year old), Ali Hussein Salah Al-Din (17 years old), Fadi Mohammad Al-Khatib, Mu'tamad Najeh Al-Khatib, Mohammad Yasser Kan'an, Ahmad Musa Ahmad Matar, Arafat Dief Salah Al-Din, Amar Deif Salah Al-Din, Adham Zeid Kan'an and Musa Mohammad Al-Hilou in Jerusalem district. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 14:00, Israeli forces positioned in Wadi Al-Juz neighbourhood in Jerusalem temporarily detained several residents after storming and searching several homes and merchant shops and confiscated surveillance camera footage from several merchant shops for alleged shooting incident towards several Israeli forces, which injured an Israeli soldier. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 10:00, Israeli forces prevented several worshipers from entering Al-Aqsa mosque compound as Israeli settlers under the protection of the Israeli Military forces and Israeli Police stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshipers during which Israeli forces fired tear gas grenades towards several residents as they attempted to prevent the settler attack and as a result injured 2 residents :Haytham Al-Nimri and Raja'i Al-Tarhi and also left several other suffocated from tear gas inhalation and also smashed several windows in Al-Aqsa mosque. • <u>Settlement Activity:</u> At 10:00, Israeli forces began levelling several plots of land near Wadi Zubaba road in Silwan neighbourhood force allegedly expanding a road on Palestinian owned land for the service of Israeli settlers. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 20:15, a group of Israeli settlers positioned near Jerusalem assaulted Hisham Hussein Hassasneh (A resident of Bethlehem) and as a result, left him hospitalised with fractured bones and contusions. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. .

(iii) Since 02:25 on July 1st 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Jalazun camp with Cement blocks. (iv) Since 16:15 on July 1st 2014, Israeli forces closed the main roads connecting Deir Izbie' and Ras Kara Kar and Kafr Ni'meh. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 21:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Deir Abu Mash'al village. (ii) At 21:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Illu

(iii) At 07:50, Israeli forces raided Atara and summoned a resident to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning. • <u>Attack:</u> At 19:30, Israeli forces positioned near “Pesagout” settlement located in east Al-Bireh city fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 17:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Ya’bad junction. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on August 4th 2014, Israeli forces raided Qabatiya and detained three residents. (ii) At 12:55, Israeli forces raided Al-Zababidah, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 16:30. (iii) At 14:15, Israeli forces raided Sanur village, clashed with several residents, set up a checkpoint at the village entrance then withdrew at 15:05. (iv) At 15:15, Israeli forces raided Masalmah village surrounded AL-Sadiq mosque then withdrew at 15:30. (v) At 04:45, Israeli forces raided Jenin and its camps, clashed with several residents as they stormed and searched several home, detained 3 residents in the camp then withdrew at 06:00. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained three residents: Mohammad Ali Abu Al-Rub, Mohammad Hussein Abu Al-Rub and Muhanad Imad Nazal in Qabatiya. (ii) Israeli forces detained three residents: Mahmoud Jamil Abu Kamil, Razin Billal Al-Madmakh and Mohammad Fouzi Al-Madmakh in Jenin camp. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 14:35, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Tayassir checkpoint and impeded the free flow of Traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> At 04:50, Israeli forces raided Al-Far’a camp, stormed three homes and assaulted Wael Muhsien Shoubaki after breaking down his home entrance door. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Suliman Samih Sawafta in Tubas city.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. (iii) At 09:40, Israeli forces closed a detour road leading to agricultural land near “Evní Heves” settlement. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the

	<p>free flow of traffic.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 10:00 and again at 22:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Shufa and Izbit Shufa villages and prevented residents from entering or exiting the villages. • <u>Raid:</u> At 15:35, Israeli forces raided Al-Baqa Al-Sharqiya. • <u>Attack:</u> At 08:00, Israeli forces positioned near wall gate (609) located in Tulkarem fired live ammunition towards several residents for alleged stoning after they protested the Israeli forces preventing them from entering the agricultural land located behind the wall and as a result injured Issam Nizar Sisan (A resident of Allar) after he was assaulted while being temporarily detained by Israeli forces then released him at a later time and reopened the wall gate at 09:00.
<p>QALQILIYA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 13:50 on July 11th 2014, Israeli forces closed the east entrance of Jinsafut village with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:15 and again at 20:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Qalqiliya. (ii) At 10:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along the main road connecting Jayyus and Azzun until 13:25. • <u>Raid:</u> At 18:20 and again at 04:00, Israeli forces raided Azzun, stormed a home (Under construction) and detained a resident. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Qussay Shaher Salim in Azzun. • <u>Attack:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:10, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Jayyus fired stun and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 21:00, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Qalqiliya fired stun and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
<p>NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Burin village junction until

(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. (iv) At 12:00, Israeli forces closed the west entrance gate leading to Kafr Al-Dik with cement blocks. (v) At 24:00, Israeli forces closed the west entrance gate leading to Deir Istiya with dirt mounds. • Checkpoints: Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za’tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Detention: At 02:55 on August 4th 2014, Israeli forces detained three residents: Islam Mahmoud Aqel, Subhi Maher Da’as and Ashraf Ibrahim Salah Al-Aqra’ during their raid into Bidya as mentioned in the previous report. • Attack: At 23:25, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Deir Istiya fired tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning
<p style="text-align: center;">JERICHO</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoints: Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • Flying Checkpoint: At 22:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Oja village junction until 02:15. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:05 and again at 01:45, Israeli forces raided Al-Oja village until 02:15. (ii) At 04:05, Israeli forces raided Aqbat Al-Jabr camp in Jericho until 05:00. • Detention: On August 3rd 2014, Israeli forces positioned at Allenby Bridge detained Thaer Ahmad Abu Daya (A resident of Ramallah) as he was returning from Jordan. • Attack: At 21:45, Israeli forces positioned at the south entrance of Jericho rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • Settler Violence: At 23:05, Israeli settlers positioned near Ein Dweik village stoned residents and vehicles then withdrew at 24:00.
<p style="text-align: center;">BETHLEHEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu’mān village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the southeaster area of the

village.

- (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunums of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities.

- **Closure of Main Roads:**

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.
- (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.
- (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.
- (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.
- (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
- (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.
- (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.

- **Flying Checkpoint:**

- (i) At 15:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along road (60) near Al-Khadr.
- (ii) At 13:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Nashash area junction located at the south entrance of Bethlehem until 15:05.

- **Raid**

- (i) At 12:10, Israeli forces raided Ush Al-Ghurab area located in east Beit Sahur then stormed and searched three homes and withdrew at 17:20.
- (ii) At 02:35, Israeli forces raided Al-Ayda camp, clashed with several residents as they stormed and searched 3 homes, detained a resident and summoned 2 residents to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning
- (iii) At 02:55, Israeli forces raided Husan village and stormed three homes.
- (iv) At 03:50, Israeli forces raided Al-Aza camp in Bethlehem and summoned two residents to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning.
- (v) At 03:55, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem and detained a resident.

- **Detention:**

- (i) On the morning of August 4th 2014, Israeli forces detained Abdel-Rahman Ysef Shaqarnah (A resident of Nihalin) as he was reporting to Israeli Intelligence for questioning based on a prior summon.
- (ii) Israeli forces positioned along road (60) near Al-Khadr detained Ghassan Ibrahim Zawahra (A resident of Al-Duhisheh camp in Bethlehem).
- (iii) Israeli forces detained Abdel-Rahman Rashid Abu Sarur in Al-Ayda camp in Bethlehem.
