JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 45 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikxa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikxa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 22:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at “Malee Adumin” settlement junction near Al-Eizariya. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 04:00 on August 6th 2014, Israeli forces raided Beit Anan village and detained. (ii) On August 6th 2014, Israeli forces raided Samir Amis area in North Jerusalem city and detained a resident. (iii) At 02:30, Israeli forces raided Qalandiya Camp and detained a Special

(ii) At 03:50, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Eizariya fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and launching fire works • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 03:20, Israeli forces detained Ibrahim Abbas Issa in Shu'fat in Shu'fat neighbourhood. (ii) Israeli forces detained Khaldoun Mohammad Jumhour in Beit Anan. (iii) Israeli forces detained Iday Ahmad Nimr Al-Louzat in Samir Amis area located in North Jerusalem. (iv) Israeli forces detained Shadi Daraghmeh in Qalandiya camp. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 22:30, Israeli forces positioned in Shu'fat neighbourhood temporarily detained Nasr Khater Abu Khdeir then released him at 00:10. • <u>Confiscation of Property:</u> On August 6th 2014, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Biddu village confiscated surveillance camera footage at a Gas station and a merchant shop owned by Ahmad Nu'man Al-Shiekh. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 09:30, Israeli settlers under the protection of the Israeli Military forces and Israeli Police stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshipers. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> On the morning of August 6th 2014, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli Police conducted Talmudic rituals near Bab Al-Salaslah gate, which leads to Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. .

(iv) Since 16:15 on July 1st 2014, Israeli forces closed the main roads connecting Deir Izbzie' and Ras Kara Kar and Kafr Ni'meh. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Um Safaa village until 12:45. TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 11:10, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic until 11:50. • <u>Raid:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on August 6th 2014, Israeli forces raided Baqa Al-Sharqiya, detained a resident after storming his home and confiscated a computer and cellular telephone. (ii) At 09:40, Israeli forces raided Bal’a and Tulkarem, inspected several water wells then withdrew at 12:15. (iii) At 11:00, Israeli forces raided Shweikiya neighbourhood in Tulkarem. (iv) At 20:00, Israeli forces raided Tulkarem and detained a resident. (v) At 02:55, Israeli forces raided Allar until 06:40. • <u>Detention:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Haytham Mahmoud Thiyab in Baqa Al-Sharqiya. (iii) Since 13:50 on July 11th 2014, Israeli forces closed the east entrance of Jinsafut village with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Qalqiliya until 13:30. (ii) At 12:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:30, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in south Qalqiliya fired stun and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.

(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 22:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Furiq until 23:25. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 02:22 on August 6th 2014, Israeli forces raided Jama’in and detained a resident. (ii) At 02:40 on August 6th 2014, Israeli forces raided Ein Beit Al-Ma’ camp in Nablus and detained a resident. (iii) At 23:05, Israeli forces raided Zuwata village, stormed two homes then withdrew at 00:45. (iv) At 01:35, Israeli forces raided Duma village and stormed a home and a Gymnasium, detained a resident then withdrew at 03:10. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Khalid Mohammad Mahmoud Zietawi in Jama’in. (ii) Israeli forces detained Ahmad Yusef Issa Abu Al-Iz in Ein Beit Al-Ma’ camp. (iii) Israeli forces detained Firas Mohammad Dawabsheh in Duma village. • <u>Attack: At</u> 18:45, Israeli Forces shot fire at civilians near the town of beith fourek for stone throwing.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. (iv) At 12:00, Israeli forces closed the west entrance gate leading to Kafr Al-Dik with cement blocks. (v) At 24:00, Israeli forces closed the west entrance gate leading to Deir Istiya with dirt mounds. • Checkpoints: Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Raid: At 19:15, Israeli forces raided Deir Istiya until 22:00

(ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.

<p style="text-align: center;">HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada’ Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron’s Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. . • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa’ towns, Al-‘Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron’s Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou’ and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 11:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along the main road leading to “Haji” settlement located in south Hebron until 13:00. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:55, at 14:30 and again at 01:45, Israeli forces raided Hebron and summoned Nasser Thiyab Ishaq Masaudeh to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning. (ii) At 12:05, Israeli forces raided Al-Thahriya and detained a resident. (iii) At 04:20, Israeli forces raided Al-Samou’, stormed a Police Station, temporally confiscated a Police officer rifle then returned it later.

GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. • Al-Shija'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. • <u>Attack:</u> On the afternoon of August 6th 2014, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line opened fire towards employees of Gaza Municipality as they were inspecting structures and buildings damaged in Al-Shija'iyah neighbourhood in east Gaza and as a result damaged their vehicle. • <u>Killing:</u> On August 6th 2014, medical crews recovered the bodied of three unidentified residents were recovered in Al-Shija'iyah neighbourhood in east Gaza.
