JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On February 7th 2014, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikxa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikxa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Attack:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:35, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Beit Duqqua fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 13:30, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Ram fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

	<p>(iii) At 13:30, Israeli forces positioned at Anata junction checkpoint fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</p> <p>(iv) At 13:40, Israeli forces positioned near “Kojav Yacoub” settlement junction fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 2 residents including a child: Mustafa Nassar (16 years old) and Nader Al-Yamani.</p> <p>(v) At 14:00 and again at 23:10, Israeli forces positioned at Ras Al-Qabsa area located between Abu Dis and Al-Eizariya fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</p> <p>(vi) At 14:20, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Sa’ayda neighbourhood in the old city of Jerusalem fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</p> <p>(vii) At 14:30, Israeli forces positioned at Qalandiya checkpoint fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured the child Mustafa Nassar (16 years old) and Daoud Hanoun after a tear gas grenade canister struck him leaving them hospitalised with contusions.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 13:00, Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound as worshipers were conducting Friday prayers, fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards residents inside the mosque and assaulted several of them while forcibly removing them from the mosque and as a result injured 4 residents: Khalil Joudeh, Mohammad Jawa’ni, Mohammad Odeh and Salah Al-Joulani and also injured Saed Hamoued and detained 6 others. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces positioned at Ras Al-Qabsa area located between Abu Dis and Al-Eizariya detained Yassin Al-Karari (17 years old). (ii) Israeli forces detained 6 residents: Ahmad Abu Turk, Mustafa bakr, Ahmad Zaki, Foad Al-Qalq, Ali Da’na and Mohammad Maqsouto in Al-Aqsa mosque compound. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 17:00, Israeli settlers stormed Qalandiya village then withdrew under the protection of Israeli forces. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za’ayem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma’ale Adumim.

(ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 08:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint beneath Yabrud Village Bridge. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on February 7th 2014, Israeli forces raided Beit Ur Al-Tahta and

	<p>detained 4 residents including 3 children.</p> <p>(ii) At 02:10, Israeli forces raided Beit Rima and summoned Mazen Hajjaj to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On February 6th 2014, Israeli forces detained Islam Al-Barghouthi (A Presidential Security Officer) in Deir Abu Mash'al. (ii) Israeli forces detained 4 residents including 3 children: Ehab Suliman (16 years old), Sabr Khadr (17 years old), Khaled Badran (17 years old) and Alaa Suliman in Beit Ur Al-Tahta. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:45, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Jalazoun camp in Beit Liqya fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 18 residents including 4 children: Mohammad Ali (15 years old), Usayed Nakhla (16 years old), Mohammad Nasr Ali (15 years old), Zied Abed Zied (16 years old), Abdel Jawad Omar Hamayel, Nassar Qatami, Abdel Nassar Samad'a, Nasser Adel, Mohammad Battat, Sharif Zamara, Omar Shaltaf, Nidal Zied, Mohammad Al-Loulou, Ibrahim Al-Haridi, Mohammad Ibrahim Zeid, , Mohammad Nakhla and Jihad Al-Masri. (ii) At 12:45, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Silwad fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning. (iii) At 15:15, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Ofar prison in Beituniya fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning and as a result injured Majdi Zaware' (15 years old) leaving him hospitalised. (iv) At 16:35, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Beit Liqya fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning. • <u>Demonstrations:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:50, a demonstration took place in Ni'lin village protesting against the construction of the wall, clashed with Israeli forces, and left several demonstrators suffocating from tear gas inhalation (ii) At 12:50, a demonstration took place in Bil'in village protesting against the construction of the wall, clashed with Israeli forces and left several demonstrators suffocating from tear gas inhalation. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:00, Israeli forces set up 2 checkpoints at the west and east entrances of Ya'bad and prevented residents from entering or leaving the area. (ii) At 17:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Silat Al-Harhiya, fired stun grenades towards several children for alleged stoning then withdrew at 18:00. • <u>Raid:</u> At 00:20, Israeli forces raided Ya'bad until 02:00. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.

(ii) At 15:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Bardala village. (iii) At 16:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at “Magolia” settlement junction , temporally detained Ayman Odeh then withdrew at 19:20.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Qalqiliya. (ii) At 17:00, Israeli forces set up checkpoint between Jayyus and Azzun. (iii) At 23:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint beneath Azzun bridge and detained a resident. • <u>Raid:</u> At 00:15 on February 7th 2014, Israeli forces raided Jit village. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Mustafa Salim beneath Azzun bridge. • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 12:00, a demonstration took place in Kafr Qaddum against the closure of the east entrance, clashed with Israeli forces as they attempted to disrupt demonstrators, injured 2 residents: Mufid Barham and Mohammad Barham after being struck with tear gas grenade canisters and left 4 demonstrators suffocating from tear gas inhalation. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma ’ale Shomron settlement.

(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara Al-checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 13:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Bruqin until 14:20. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 11:30, Israeli settlers stormed agricultural land in Bruqin then withdrew at 13:00. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.
<p style="text-align: center;">JERICHO</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 18:25 Israeli forces continue to intensify its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 11:20 Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along road (90) near Al-Nu'emeh village located at the north entrance of Jericho until 14:00. • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 14:35, demonstration took place on land in the north Jordan valley (which is an area under threat of Israeli confiscation) were demonstrators set up several tents to create Ein Hijleh village in order to establish Palestinian presence on land occupied in 1967 during which Israeli forces surrounded the area during which Israeli forces temporarily detained several demonstrators, interrogated them and detained a resident. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Ayman Odeh

(ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road

(ii) At 20:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the west entrance of Beit Fajjar until 22:10. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:20 and again at 19:40, Israeli forces raided Al-Obidiya. (ii) At 22:20, Israeli forces raided Wadi Fuqin until 22:40. (iii) At 01:50, Israeli forces raided Al-Doha until 01:30. (iv) At 01:50, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem, stormed a home, summoned Mohammad Al-Khatib to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 02:50. • <u>Attack:</u> At 19:40, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of Billal bin Rabah mosque located in North Bethlehem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning • <u>Demonstration:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:45, a demonstration took place in Al-Walaja village, planted several Olive trees on land under threat of Israeli confiscation during which Israeli forces stormed the area and temporarily detained Hamza Shanair then released him at 14:00 (ii) At 12:40, a demonstration took place in Al-Ma’asra village protesting against the construction of the wall and against the prevention of protestors from reaching the demonstration site. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction resumed in North West of Beit Jala town. (ii) On May 1st 2013, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village. (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada’ Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron’s Old City. In addition to

closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.

- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. .

- **Closure of Main Roads:**

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.

- (vi) Since December 27th 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks.

- (vii) Since 09:45 on September 23rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to "Haji" settlement and impeded the free flow of traffic.

- **Raid:**

- (i) At 00:35, Israeli forces raided Al-Samou'.
- (ii) At 05:30, Israeli forces raided Ithna.

- **Injury:** At 12:10, Abdallah Jabarin (15 years old) was injured after an Israeli UXO exploded near Sha'b Al-Batm area near "Magon" settlement in Yatta.

- **Temporary Detention:** At 13:40, Israeli forces positioned at a checkpoint near Al-Rajabi neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron temporarily detained Husam Jaber, confiscated his identification card, sprayed pepper spray onto his face leaving his suffocated and hospitalised with burnt eyes after releasing him.

- **Attack:**

- (i) At 14:45, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Shalashleh road in the old city of Hebron fired tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning.
- (ii) At 16:30, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Urub camp fired rubber coated steel bullets; stun and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning.
- (iii) At 16:50, Israeli forces positioned near Khursa village junction fired rubber coated steel bullets; stun and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning.
- (iv) At 22:20, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Beit Ummar fired stun and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning and detained a child.

- **Detention:**

- (i) At 18:30, Israeli forces detained Moath Sabarna at the entrance of Beit Ummar.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Oday (17 years old) in Beit Ummar.

- **Wall Construction:** Wall construction resumed in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahriya town.
