JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 40 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Khan Al-Ahmar (along the main road connecting Jerusalem and Jericho), temporarily seized and searched two Security Force vehicles (1 Police vehicle and 1 Security Force vehicle) then allowed them to pass through at 11:15. (ii) At 11:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Ram junction. (iii) At 21:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Anata. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 01:30 on March 9th 2015, Israeli forces raided Beit Anan village and detained a resident. (ii) At 04:00 on March 9th 2015, Israeli forces raided Biddu and detained two residents including a child. (iii) At 02:15, Israeli forces raided Kafr Aqab village, clashed with several residents and as a result injured two residents including a child: Salah Hamad (17 years old) and Moath Hamad then withdrew at 03:50. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:50 on March 8th 2015, Israeli forces detained five residents including two children: Mohammad Al-Sayad (17 years old), Judeh Abu Jum’a, Omar Abu Al-Hawa, Mahmoud Abu Al-Hawa and Doud Sbitan. (ii) At 10:30, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Magharba gate (A main entrance gate leading to Al-Aqsa mosque compound) detained Hanadi Al-Hilwani (A resident of Wadi Al-Juz neighbourhood) as she was exiting Al-Aqsa mosque. (iii) At 11:30, Israeli forces detained Husam Samour (A Security Guard at Al-

(ii) At 20:40, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Tur and Wadi Al-Juz neighbourhoods in Jerusalem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Assault on Property:</u> At 10:30, Israeli forces prevented rehabilitation construction work on A;-Isharfiya school inside Al-Aqsa mosque compound. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 10:30, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli Police stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshippers. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

(ii) At 14:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Atarah bridge located in North Bir Zeit and detained a resident. (iii) At 17:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near “Halamish” settlement junction and detained a resident. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on March 9th 2015, Israeli forces raided Shuqba village, detained a resident and summoned Issa Thabet to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning. (ii) At 24:00, Israeli forces raided Beit Rima until 03:00. (iii) At 02:30, Israeli forces raided Deir Ghassaneh village until 03:40. (iv) At 02:40, Israeli forces raided Ein-Yabrud village, summoned two residents: Zuhier Huhui and Mohammad Za’tout to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 02:50. (v) At dawn on March 10th 2015, Israeli forces raided Bi’in village, stormed and searched nine homes and summoned Mohammad Ash’al to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces positioned at Atrah Bridge detained Bassam Masalmi (A resident of Tubas). (ii) Israeli forces positioned near “Halamis” settlement junction detained Ahmad Saber (A resident of Salfit). (iii) Israeli forces detained Ismail Thabet in Suqba village.

<p>JENIN</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 09:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Deir Abu Da’if until 11:05. • <u>Raid:</u> At 04:30, Israeli forces raided Ya’bad, stormed two homes and detained a resident. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Nour Jawabrah in Ya’bad. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Israeli forces continue to close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.
<p>TULKAREM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Detention:</u> At 15:10, Israeli forces detained Qassem Badir (A resident of Tulkarem) as he was reporting to Israeli Intelligence for questioning based on a prior summon.
<p>QALQILIYA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far’ata village which is located near “Gillad” settlement with dirt mounds • <u>Raid:</u> At 00:45, Israeli forces raided Jayyus, summoned 2 residents: Fadi Saleem and Mohammad Bayda to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 01:30. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
<p>NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and

(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 16:00, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 17:00. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:05, Israeli force set up a checkpoint between Deir Ballut and Rafaat village until 20:00. (ii) At 23:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Kafil Harris until 00:15.
<p>JERICHO</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • <u>Raid:</u> At 22:25, Israeli forces raided Jericho until 00:10.
<p>BETHLEHEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) At 20:05, Israeli forces raided Al-Khadr then withdrew at 20:30. (iii) At 01:30, Israeli forces raided Taqou', stormed and searched several homes, detained 18 residents including two children then withdrew at 04:25. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained 18 residents including two children: Ahmad Sabah (17 years old), Ibrahim Sabah (17 years old), Marwan Sabah, Zakiya Sabah, Amjad Sabah, Saher Sabah, Safer Sabah, Atiyah Sabah, Ma'moun Sabah, Mohammad Saleem Sabah, Ayoub Sabah, Iz Sabah, Jafar Sabah, Sami Sabah, Mohammad Ali Sabah, Thaer Sabah, Ahmad Atiyah Sabah, Mohammad Suliman Sabah and Maher Sabah. • <u>Attack:</u> At 17:20, Israeli forces positioned near the west entrance of Taqou' fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Land Levelling:</u> On the evening of March 9th 2015, Israeli forces levelled approximately 400 dunumes (acres) of agricultural land Baten Al-Ma'asi and Um Mohammad in area's located in Al-Khadr .
<p>HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.

- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
 - (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.

 - (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of "Al-Nahda" and "Al Rabi'a Al-Odwiya" schools and in the vicinity of "Al-Karnitina" and "Tal'at Al-Takrouri" areas and in the vicinity of the Islamic cemetery in the old city of Hebron fired stun and tear gas grenades while conducting military exercises and as a result injured the child Akram Ghayth (9 years old) leaving him hospitalised with contusions after being struck by a tear gas grenade canister to the hand.
 - (ii) At 17:00, Israeli forces positioned in Jabal Juhar area in the old city of Hebron fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
 - **Confiscation of Property:** At 01:40, Israeli forces confiscated surveillance cameras and a cellular telephone owned by Imad Abu Shamsiya after storming his home in Tel Al-Rumayda neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron.
