JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli army continues to intensify their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikxa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikxa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:30 on November 16th 2013, Israeli forces raided Al-Ram, stormed a home summoned Moath AL-Za’tari to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning. (ii) At 02:30 on November 17th 2013, Israeli forces raided Beit Duqqu and summoned Osama Talal to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning. (iii) At 06:30 on November 17th 2013, Israeli forces raided Al-Isawiya village and detained 2 children. (iv) At 10:30, Israeli raided Abu Dis, clashed with several Al-Quds University students and as a result injured 25 University students as well as leaving approximately 55 others suffocated from tear gas inhalation during which

	<p>Israeli forces stormed Al-Quds University Campus and damaged the main entrance to the College of Sciences and shattered windows of the University mosque.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained 2 children: Mohammad Dari (16 years old) and Mohammad Obied (16 years old) in Al-Isawiya village. • <u>Injury:</u> At 13:15, Israeli forces assaulted Rakan Abu Sarha, a resident of Bethlehem as he was in Jerusalem and as a result left him hospitalised with contusions. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 09:55, Israeli forces positioned at Jaba' checkpoint located along the main road connecting Jerusalem, Ramallah and Jericho temporarily detained Isam Zaynab , a resident of Jericho then released him at 13:45. • <u>Home Demolition:</u> On November 17th 2013, Israeli forces stormed Al-Qarami neighbourhood in the old city of Jerusalem and served a demolition order to demolish a section of a home (Kitchen) owned by Nasri Abu Rajab. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 09:20, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshippers. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.

(ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Atara bridge. (ii) At 19:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Taybeh junction until 20:05. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:55, Israeli forces raided Silwad, clashed with its residents and temporarily detained the child Yazan Hamad (13 years old) then released him at 13:50. (ii) At 21:20, Israeli forces raided Beitin village, opened fire randomly, detained a resident then withdrew at 23:00. (iii). • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Nassar Musa Nassar in Beitin village. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.
<p>JENIN</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 22:20, Israeli forces raided Faqou'a village until 23:20. (ii) At 02:20, Israeli forces raided Al-Zabada and Masalma villages. (iii) At 02:20, Israeli forces raided Jenin, detained a resident as they stormed a home, smashed the windows of a home then withdrew at 05:30. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Jamal Irshid in Jenin. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 13:30, Israeli forces positioned at "Movo Dotan" checkpoint located in south Ya'bad along the main road connecting Jenin and Tulkarem, temporarily detained Amar Amarneh, a resident of Ya'bad then released him at 20:20. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u>, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at "Eniv: checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces raided Tulkarem and Tulkarem camp, stormed a coffee shop and several merchant shops, temporarily detained several residents and released them after questioning then withdrew at 10:30. (ii) At 13:30, Israeli forces raided Kafr Al-Labad village as they escorted a group of scientists who conducted tests on several water wells in the village then withdrew at 14:30. (iii) At 14:30, Israeli forces raided Dier Al-Ghsun. (iv) At 15:10, Israeli forces raided Bal'a, clashed with several residents and as a result suffocated the child: Osama Hamdan (16 years old) and was hospitalised from tear gas inhalation. (v) At 00:20, Israeli forces raided Rammin village and clashed with its residents. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Raid:</u> At 00:35, Israeli forces raided Habalat. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate closed the steel gate at 11:55 and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction was continued in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of

	Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma 'ale Shomron settlement.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Closure of Checkpoint:</u> At 20:35, Israeli forces closed Huwara checkpoint as they temporarily detained the child: Ibrahim Jarar (16 years old), a resident of Nablus for allegedly carrying a suspicious object then released him at 00:50. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Furiq until 09:45. (ii) At 08:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Qussin village until 09:00. (iii) At 09:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Ussirin village until 11:00. (iv) At 14:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Bazzariya village junction until 14:55. (v) At 21:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at "Shav Shomron" settlement junction until 22:00. (vi) At 22:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Talluza and Al-Bithan villages, opened fire then withdrew at 00:30.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara Al-checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 19:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Qarwat Bani Hassan village junction until 21:30. • <u>Provocation of Palestinian Security Forces:</u> At 12:45, Israeli forces positioned at Za'tara checkpoint seized a Palestinian National Security forces vehicle then released it after searching the vehicle. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 19:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Ein Dweik village located in North Jericho until 21:30.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village.

	<p>(ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) At 14:00, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. (viii) At 14:40, Israeli forces closed the bypass road leading to Khirbeit Al-Dier village with concrete blocks • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 11:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the west entrance of Taqou'. • <u>Raid:</u> At 02:40, Israeli forces raided Al-Obidiya, stormed several homes, detained 3 residents including 2 children then withdrew at 04:45. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 03:00 on November 17th 2013, Israeli forces detained Jamil Khadr Jamil during their raid into Bethlehem as mentioned in the previous report. (ii) Israeli forces detained 3 residents: Ahmad Hassana (16 years old), Ahed Hassana (17 years old) and Rashed Hassaneh during their raid into Al-Obidiya . • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction has continued in North West of Beit Jala town. (ii) On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village. (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the

HEBRON

Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. .

- **Closure of Main Roads:**

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- (vi) Since December 27th 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks.
- (vii) Since 09:45 on September 23rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to "Haji" settlement and impeded the free flow of traffic

- **Flying checkpoint:**

- (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces set up 7 checkpoints at the north entrance of Hebron, Wadi Qabbun area located in North Hebron, Beit Anun village junction, Al-Karanita area in the old city of Hebron, Sinjir area located between Hebron and Dura, at the entrance of Beit Awa and in the area between Yatta and Hebron.
- (ii) At 20:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Halhul bridge until 21:30.

- **Raid:**

- (i) At 11:40, Israeli forces raided Ithna.
- (ii) At 20:40, Israeli forces raided Hebron and set up a checkpoint.
- (iii) At 02:40, Israeli forces raided Surif village.

- **Detention:** At 18:00, Israeli forces detained Nur Abu Sineneh in the old city of Hebron.

- **Attack:** At 11:20, Israeli forces positioned in the old city of Hebron fired tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

- **Assault on Property:** On November 17th 2013, Israeli forces served a halt to construction notices to cease construction of a Mosque in Al-Dirat village located in east Yatta during which Israeli forces confiscated several tons of Cement and 70 m of Marble slab as well as several other construction items.

- **Settler Violence:** At 21:15, Israeli settlers stormed agricultural land in Wadi Mu'ien area located in south Yatta and uprooted and damaged 106 Olive trees owned by Omar Mu'sif and Abed Mus'ef..

- **Wall Construction:** Wall construction continued in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town.

At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. • On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles. • Israeli Naval vessels broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza.
