- (i) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandia checkpoint.

• <u>Checkpoints:</u>

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city.
- (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- (iii) At 10:30, Israeli forces increased its restrictions at Ja'aba checkpoint, searched vehicles with bomb sniffing dogs and impeded the free flow of traffic.
- <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> On the morning of December 24th 2012, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa Mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshipers.

- <u>Raid:</u> At 01:25, Israeli forces raided Taqou', stormed a home and summoned Rami Hajajha to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning.
 Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in North West of Beit Jala
 - town.
 Closure:
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
 - (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to the entrance to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) On July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.

• Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 11:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Ramadin village.
- (ii) At 14:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Fuwar junction.
- (iii) At 16:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Sa'ir.
- (iv) At 20:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Tarqumiya.

• Raid:

- (i) At 19:005, Israeli forces raided Tarusat.
- (ii) At 21:00, Israeli forces raided Hebron.
- (iii) At 03:00, Israeli forces raided Beit Ulla and stormed a home.
- (iv) At dawn on December 25th 2012, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar, stormed several homes and detained 3 residents including a child and a University student.
- <u>Attack:</u> At 16:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Beit Ummar fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards residents participating in funeral precisions for alleged stoning, injured Hiyan Abu Ayash and several other suffocated from tear gas inhalation.

• Detention:

- (i) At 16:00, Israeli forces detained Hatem Al-Batsh in the old city of Hebron.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained Rashid Awad (17 years old), Mohammad Awad and Sharif Abu Ayash in Beit Ummar.
- <u>Settler Violence:</u> On the evening of December 24th 2012, an Israeli settler ran over Mohammad Za'akik (15 years old) with his vehicle leaving him hospitalised with severe injuries and contusions during which Israeli forces clashed with several residents for alleged stoning.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction was halted in the area surrounding

GAZA STRIP

ALL DISTRICTS	 At 21:00 on November 21st 2012, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. On November 24th 2012, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark.
NORTHERN GAZA	 Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination as well as allowing Christians to travel to Bethlehem.
GAZA	 Closure of Crossing Points: Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
RAFAH	 Closure of Crossing Points: Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. Rafah (Al 'Awdah) Crossing is open for the exit of patients, students, passengers with permits and International aid including 35 truckloads of imported goods. Sufa Crossing is closed. Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the entry of humanitarian supplies, cooking gas, truckloads of wheat and Livestock feed as well 35 truckloads of imported goods and construction material for internationally funded projects.
