JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound (In Commemoration with the 66 anniversary of Al-Nakba (Catastrophe)). (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:00 and again ta 19:00, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in

	<p>Abu Dis, fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</p> <p>(ii) At 19:00, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Ram junction fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Obstruction of Places of Worship:</u> At 09:00, Israeli settlers and several Israeli Cabinet members under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshippers. • <u>Detention:</u> On May 28th 2014, Israeli forces detained 7 residents: Thaer Al-Fajouri, Omar Tiem, Walid Fayuori, Mohammad Fayouri, Omar Fayoiuri, Osama Al-Ajlouni and Muhanad Al-Housari in the old city of Jerusalem. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 09:00, a group of Israeli settlers assaulted and injured the child Mohammad Al-Qam (16 years old), a resident of Shu'fat as he was in Jerusalem leaving him hospitalised with contusions. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.

(ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. (iii) Since 00:20 on March 4th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Al-Jalazun camp and Bet El settlement with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> At 18:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Atara bridge and detained a resident. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 02:00 on May 29th 2014, Israeli forces raided Deir Jerier village and detained a resident. (ii) At 19:40, Israeli forces raided Aboud, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 20:00. (iii) At 23:45, Israeli forces raided Deir Nathim village, stormed and searched a home then withdrew at 24:00. (iv) At 01:55, Israeli forces raided Beituniya, stormed and searched a home, confiscated a computer and surveillance footage from a security camera for a home then withdrew at 03:00. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 00:30 on May 29th 2014, Israeli forces detained Mohammad Sa'edat during their raid into Al-Jalazun as mentioned in the previous report. (ii) Israeli forces detained Adham Mizher near Atara bridge. (iii) Israeli forces Abdel Halim Farajneh detained in Deir Nathim village. • <u>Attack:</u> At 09:50, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Beituniya fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.

(ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Ya’bad and Zibada village until 14:00. (ii) At 21:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Yamoun until 23:30. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:50, Israeli forces raided Al-Zababida, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 11:00. (ii) At 10:50, Israeli forces raided Ya’bad, stormed a merchant shop then withdrew at 11:20. (iii) At 11:05, Israeli forces raided Rabba village, stormed 3 homes, summoned Layth Bazour to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 03:00. (iv) At 05:00, Israeli forces raided Anza village , stormed several homes, summoned 2 University students : Suhayeb Attani and Omar Sadaqa to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 05:45 • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.

<p style="text-align: center;">TULKAREM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 16:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along AL-Kafriyat road which connects Tulkarem and Qalqiliya, temporarily detained several residents and released them after questioning by Israeli Intelligence officers and withdrew at 18:30. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 14:50, Israeli forces temporarily detained Ziyad Amarnah, a resident of Anata as he was herding his goats then released him at 16:00. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is prevented to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall then allowed them to pass through at 09:30.
<p style="text-align: center;">QALQILIYA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 18:00, a demonstration took place in Kafr Qaddum village protesting against Israeli detention of village residents during which Israeli forces fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several demonstrators leaving them suffocating from tear gas inhalation.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma ’ale Shomron settlement.
<p>NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 03:25, Israeli forces raided Balata and Ein Beit Al-Ma ‘camps in Nablus and detained a resident in Balata camp. (ii) At 04:20 on May 29th 2014, Israeli forces raided Awarta village and detained a resident. (iii) At 19:10, Israeli forces raided Osarin village, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 19:40. (iv) At 20:15, Israeli forces raided Al-Laban Al-Sharqiya, temporarily detained 2 children: Mus’ab Oweid (17 years old) and Mohammad Daraghmeh (17 years old) then released them at 22:00. (v) At 03:00, Israeli forces raided the east neighbourhood in Nablus until 03:20. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:55, Israeli forces detained Raed Nijim, a resident of Huwara for alleged stoning. (ii) Israeli forces detained Baha Mansour in Balata Camp. (iii) Israeli forces detained Salah Qawariq in Awarta village. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 18:10, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed agricultural land in Burin village and attempted to steal several goats owned by Waleid Eid , stoned several residents and vehicles and as a result damaged Billal Eids vehicle and chopped off the limbs of several Olive trees during which Israeli forces fired stun and tear gas grenades towards residents as they attempted to repel the settler attack and withdrew at 19:45
<p>SALFIT</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks.

JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Oja village junction until 10:00. (ii) At 20:00, Israeli force set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho until 20:50. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 20:30, an Israeli settler vehicle ran over and injured the child Mahdi Mohammad (10 years old) near road (90) on Al-Oja village leaving him hospitalised with severe contusions.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunums of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:05, Israeli forces raided Taqou', clashed with residents and as a result suffocated Eman Al-Badan from tear gas inhalation until 13:20. (ii) At 00:55, Israeli forces raided Al-Ma'sara village, stormed Hussein Barajas home and warned him about participating in demonstrations against construction of the wall then withdrew at 02:00. • <u>Home Demolition:</u> At 5:00 on May 29th 2014, Israeli forces served a demolition order for a home owned by Imad Doud for allegedly being built with outa licence. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction resumed in North West of Beit Jala town. (ii) On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village. (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.
<p>HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. . • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. (vi) Since December 27th 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks. (vii) Since 09:45 on September 23rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to "Haji" settlement and impeded the free flow of traffic. (viii) Since March 9th 2014, Israeli forces opened a steel gate in Beit Anun. (ix) Since March 9th 2014, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Al-Rihana area in east Yatta. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Announ village until 09:30. (ii) At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Wadi Qabun area in North Hebron until 10:40.

At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. • On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles. • Israeli Naval vessels broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Gaza. .

<p style="text-align: center;">GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shuja'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. • <u>Attack:</u> On the morning of May 29th 2014, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats as they approached them off the shores of Gaza and detained 4 fishermen as well as confiscating their fishing boat. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained 4 fishermen: Sa'ed Al-Adgham, Yahya Abu Tafa, Foad Al-Habal and Haytham Al-Habal off the shores of Gaza.
