In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. . • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. Later on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease-fire. • On November 14th 2011, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza’s seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles. • Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by raiding and opening fire and launching tank Artillery shells towards North Gaza, Central Gaza, Khan Yunis and Rafah .Tank Artillery fire target several mosques and Beit Hanoun hospital • Israeli fighter jets broke the cease fire agreement by launching missiles in 659 consecutive strikes towards Palestinian gunmen in North Gaza, Gaza, Central Gaza Khan Yunis and Rafah and as a result killed 104 residents including 10 Women and 14 children, 4 journalists and a Paramedic{ which increases the number of civilians killed to 1360 including 317 children and 176 women and injured 645 residents which increases in the number of resident injured since the Israeli Attack on Gaza to 7615 including 2229 Children, 1560 Women. • Israeli airstrikes damaged 18 Hospitals and health clinics since the Israeli assault on the Gaza Strip. • Israeli airstrikes damaged 147 schools and 5 Universities since the Israeli assault on
